Multi-child Discount

The following discount is for families with more than two students. The percentage discount will be applied to the tuition and book-fee for all students in a household combined. This discount is available only to full-time students and all K4 students. If a child drops out midyear, the discount will be adjusted accordingly for the remaining students.

3 Students	10% total discount
4 Students	20% total discount
5 Students	30% total discount
6 Students	40% total discount
7 Students or more	50% total discount

Tuition Assistance for Members of Christ Church

If an applicant or a currently enrolled family of Christ Church Academy is in need of tuition assistance due to financial hardship, and they are a tithing member of Christ Church, they must complete the following steps:

- 1. Contact the CCA Administrator for a "Tuition Assistance" Application.
- 2. Submit the completed application along with a copy (digital or physical) of their household's previous year's tax returns within 10 days of receiving the application.
- 3. Once all information has been submitted, an interview will be scheduled with the CCA Administrator to determine eligibility and receive biblical financial counseling as needed. The following information will be expected to be provided during the interview:
 - a. Typical hours worked each week of the head of the household.
 - b. Total Amount and Types of Debt.
 - c. Monthly Payments to Debt (including mortgage).
 - d. Other education expenses (tuition, daycare, etc.).
 - e. Estimation of actual monthly household expenses over the last six months.
 - f. If applicable, a copy of the household's monthly budget.
 - i. If the household does not have a monthly budget, a budget worksheet will be provided by the CCA Administrator and will need to be completed by the time of the interview.
 - g. Any other particular information requested by the CCA Administrator when the interview is scheduled.
- 4. Once the interview has been conducted, the CCA Administrator will present the information to the board to determine the level of assistance (if any) and any other requirements that may be conditional to the assistance.
 - a. Applicants will be notified by the CCA Administrator once this process is concluded.

NOTE: Any tuition assistance awarded will most likely be partial. Only in the rarest of circumstances will the total costs be waived. This is in the best interests of the school and our families so that everyone remains financially invested in the success of the school to some degree.
